#### What is a NILALEG Grant?

The NILALEG grant, administered by the Environmental Investment Fund of Namibia aims to enhance collaborative sustainable solutions for biodiversity and people, focusing on critical landscapes of:

- Omaoipanga, Kunene Region
- Ruacana, Omusati and Kunene Regions
- Okongo, Ohangwena Region
- Nkulivere, Kavango West Region
- Zambezi, Zambezi Region

Under this programme, organized beneficiaries within these landscapes are invited to submit project proposals of which budgets range between US\$10,000 - US\$46,000 (Approximately N\$ 150,000 - N\$ 736,000) and which contribute to the achievement of the programme's goals.

#### Who is eligible to apply?

We invite applications from:

- Community based Organizations (CBOs) including informal community groups;
- Farmer's Associations;
- Gazetted Conservancies;
- Gazetted Community Forests;
- Youth groups;
- Women's organizations

## How do I apply for a NILALEG Grant?

Interested organizations meeting the eligibility criteria can find the details on the NILALEG grants programme, including the application form on the Environmental Investment Fund and MEFT websites.

### Approval process

Proposals are evaluated at various stages and approved on merit. The approval process takes at least 60 days from the deadline.
